(*applicable to self-funded and externally-sponsored students)

Standard entitlements for research students studying on campus at Leeds Beckett University

Work space

- Hot-desk provision within a suitable shared space. This should be available from 9am to 9pm
- The shared space should have access to a telephone with the facility to make UK calls
- Work space facility available in the Library 24/7.

Resources

- One laptop with bag (full-time students only)
- Two data sticks
- Campus ID card and student university email
- Access to all library facilities
- Access to other libraries and the British Library at Boston Spa
- Access to research training provision through in-house and online workshops (such as Epigeum).*

Workshop, seminar and conference attendance

This will be pro-rata depending on the research degree being studied.

- A financial contribution to support attendance at no more than three external events (including training courses, workshops, seminars and conferences) during the period of study. These are to be negotiated and agreed between the student, Director of Studies and the Director of Research.

Teaching opportunities

The opportunity to be considered for teaching-related activities where appropriate.

General

- Students are encouraged to become members of the Postgraduate Research Society.
- All students are eligible to buy an NUS card and sports membership card.

Work space (when visiting Leeds Beckett University)

- Work space facility available in the Library 24/7
- Access to other libraries and the British Library at Boston Spa.
