

Validation and Re-validation

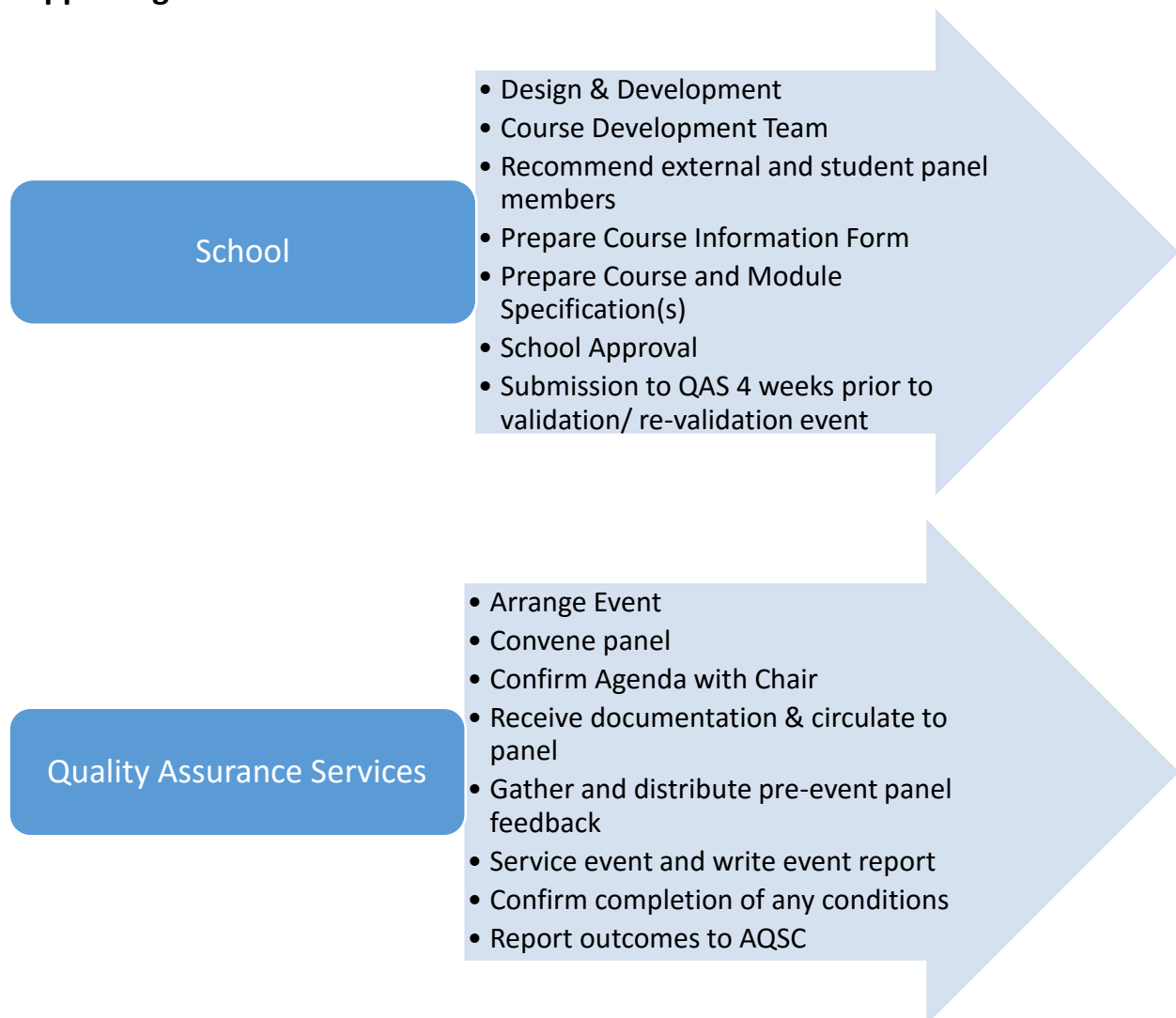
The validation and re-validation enables our University to set and maintain appropriate academic standards for our courses and make available learning opportunities which enable the intended learning outcomes to be achieved by our students.

Validation and Re-validation is a peer review process drawing on internal and external expertise from academics, professionals and students. All new courses are subject to validation and thereafter re-validation within a six-year cycle or sooner. A Course will follow the following processes:



Where provision is intended for delivery in a collaborative context a further process of in-country approval is required following validation and re-validation.
