CAR PARKING AT CARNEGIE VILLAGE

Difficulties have been experienced in the management of car parking at and around Carnegie Village. These have been brought to the University's attention by local councillors, who are voicing the legitimate concerns of the local community about traffic and parking congestion in the area.

As a result of these problems, the City Council has formally reminded the University of its Obligations in this regard as set out in the Planning Agreement which underpinned the building and operation of the Carnegie Village site.

It is in the interests of students/residents, the local community, the City Council and the University to ensure that parking levels and practices in this area do not contravene this Agreement.

In order to reinforce our commitment to observing our obligations, **you must agree to abide by the following regulations regarding vehicle use at Carnegie Village:-**

CAR PARKING AT CARNEGIE VILLAGE

Residents who do not have a valid parking permit, shall NOT, on any occasion during their licence agreement at Carnegie Village Student Residences, bring any vehicle onto that site; Nor shall they park any vehicle in the vicinity thereof during that period (except when moving in or moving out at the beginning and end of each Semester).
