Interview Guidance

Congratulations on gaining an interview for our **BA (Hons) Illustration** course (UCAS course code **W210**). The information in this booklet will assist you in preparing for your interview and will give you an idea of what to expect on the day.

From your application we feel that you have the attributes and qualities required to succeed at Leeds Beckett. The formal interview process will provide us with the opportunity to further assess your suitability to study on the course and help us, and you, make that decision. It is important that you use the opportunity to ensure the university and course meet your needs as a learner.

We hope that you will enjoy your time at Leeds Beckett University. Please remember that an interview is a two-way process and you should treat the interview as an opportunity to ask the course team questions so you leave us with sufficient knowledge to make your decision wisely.

What to do now

You should check your UCAS Hub for confirmation of the date and time of your interview and ensure you accept it to confirm you will be attending.

If you are no longer able to attend the date you previously booked, please contact the team to request another date by emailing ucasadmissions@leedsbeckett.ac.uk as soon as possible

What to prepare in advance/bring with you on the day

Please bring a portfolio that demonstrates your work to date and the standards achieved. Examples should evidence a range of ideas, skills, interests and experimental explorations. This can be in physical or digital formats – whichever is applicable to your practice to date. Please bring with you a sample of your developmental work: sketchbooks, drawings, photographs where applicable. It is not advisable to bring large or fragile items – photographs would be perfectly acceptable.

You'll also need to bring your photographic ID (passport or driving licence) which will be checked at your interview. If you do not have this please bring along your birth certificate.

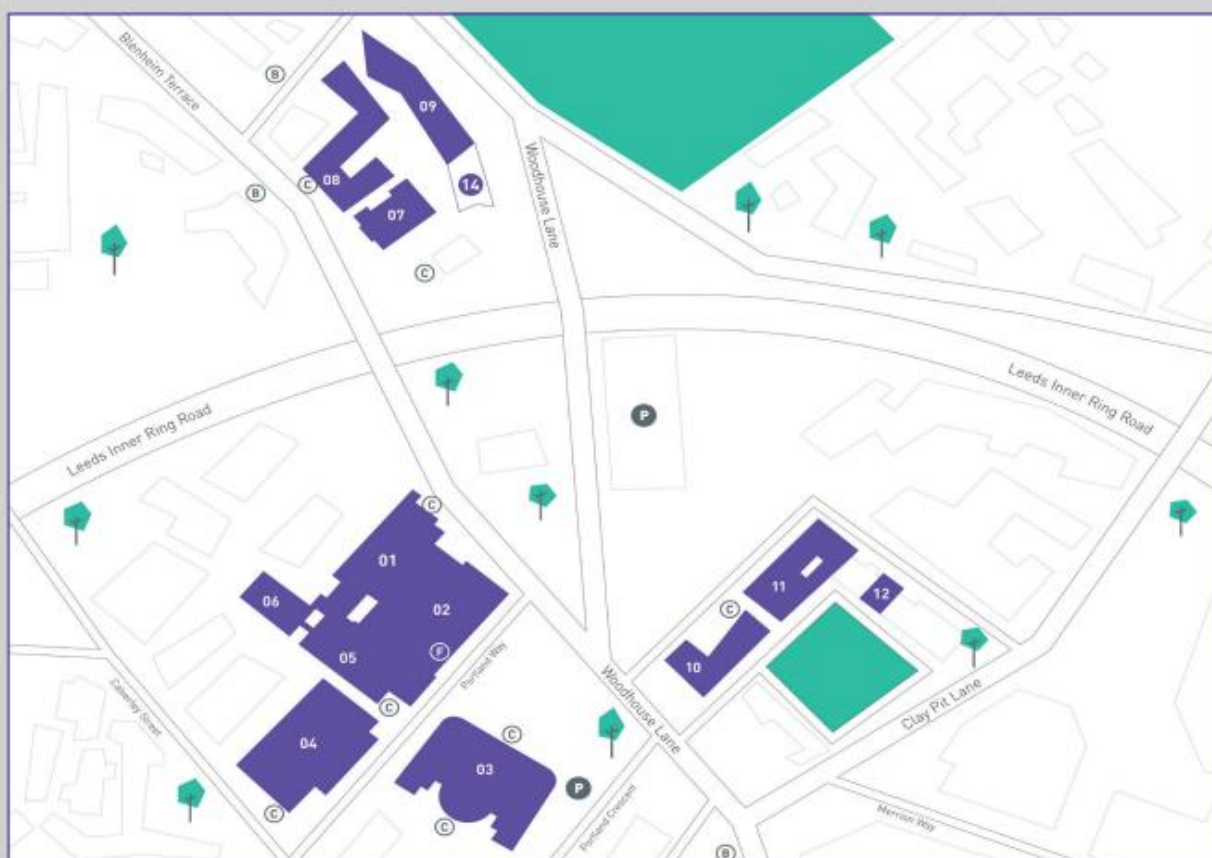

On the Day

On arrival you will be directed to where your interview will take place. You will be given a subject presentation followed by an interview which will last approximately 20 – 30 minutes. There will also be an opportunity for you to meet some of our students and have a tour of the studios, facilities and workshop areas.

Your interview will focus on:

- Your ability to convey enthusiasm and interest in the subject and its study
- Creative thinking and ability
- Self-motivation and tenacity
- Social and cultural awareness
- The ability to describe and evaluate work
- Knowledge and understanding of art and design practices

You should plan to be at your interview for the full session and you should make travel arrangements accordingly. Please allow approximately 3 hours for your interview at Leeds Beckett University.
