### **Audition Guidance**

Congratulations on gaining an audition for our **BA (Hons) Music Performance and Production** course (UCAS course code **W310**). The information in this booklet will assist you in preparing for your audition and will give you an idea of what to expect on the day.

From your application we feel that you have the attributes and qualities required to succeed at Leeds Beckett. The formal audition process will provide us with the opportunity to further assess your suitability to study on the course and help us, and you, make that decision. It is important that you use the opportunity to ensure the university and course meet your needs as a learner.

We hope that you will enjoy your time at Leeds Beckett University. Please remember that an interview is a two-way process and you should treat the interview as an opportunity to ask the course team questions so you leave us with sufficient knowledge to make your decision wisely.

### **What to do now**

## On the Day

There will be a short introductory presentation about the course, followed by group auditions.

Ensemble work is central to the course and you'll participate in a group performance workshop as part of your interview day.

We have guitar and bass amps, keyboards and drum kits, but you should bring other instruments with you if possible. Drummers, please bring your sticks.

We anticipate that the session will be finished by 17:00. If you attend the day with family members or other guests, they will be invited to wait in the nearby Food Court and café area.
