Interview Guidance

Congratulations on gaining an interview for our BSc (Hons) Physiotherapy course. The information in this booklet will assist you in preparing for your interview and will give you an idea of what to expect on the day.

You have been selected for interview on the strength of your application. We feel you demonstrate a range of attributes and qualities that indicate you have the potential to succeed as a healthcare professional. The process requires you to attend a formal online interview so that we have a chance to consider your suitability for our course. The interview will take place via an online platform called Microsoft Teams and will last approximately 20 minutes. You too must decide, based on your findings at interview, as to which university and course you think would best meet your needs as a learner.

Do remember that an interview is a two-way process and that you should treat the interview as an opportunity to ask the course team questions.

What to prepare in advance of the interview?

Prior to your interview please ensure you have access to Microsoft Teams with video connection. ***If you will be accessing Microsoft Teams from a different email address to that on your UCAS application, please let us know as soon as possible.***

You will be sent a link to your interview prior to your interview, if you have not received this 24 hours before your interview please let us know on 0113 812 5946. Please make sure you have checked your spam/junk filter before contacting us.

On the Day

Prior to your interview date you will be emailed a link to access your individual interview “room”. Please access the “room” 5 minutes before the start of your interview where you will be met by a member of the academic teaching team who will conduct your interview. They will check your photographic ID at the start of the interview.

What the interview will involve

The interview is designed to identify those applicants who demonstrate the values that align with the NHS Constitution as well as those who evidence the right skills and aptitude in accordance with Values Based Recruitment. We will also use the interview as an opportunity to explore the detail of your personal statement.

Should you require any additional support with learning needs, or have any special requirements for attendance, please email ucasadmissions@leedsbeckett.ac.uk as soon as possible. Please ensure your email includes your UCAS Personal ID number, the title of the course you have applied for and the date of your interview.

After your interview

If you are successful following your interview, we will process an offer of a place on the course via your UCAS Hub account. If you are unsuccessful, we will also notify you via your UCAS Hub account. If you would like feedback following an unsuccessful decision, you should contact us at ucasadmissions@leedsbeckett.ac.uk to request this.

Please be aware that in some cases we may not be able to process a decision until all interviews have been completed, and so you may not receive a decision until the end of April 2024. If this is the case, your application will be placed on hold, and we will notify you of this via email. A decision will be processed as soon as possible, and you will receive notification when a decision has been made via your UCAS Hub.

Your results

Depending upon the conditions of your offer and the type of qualifications you are studying, your results may be sent directly to us between June and August. Alternatively, we may contact you directly to ask you to send us your results once you have received them.

Disclosure and Barring Service/Health checks

If you select Leeds Beckett University as your firm choice, we will send you further details in the summer about completing a DBS (formerly Criminal Record Bureau) enhanced check and the occupational health screening questionnaire. If your contact details change between now and May, please ensure you advise us of this change via email to ucasadmissions@leedsbeckett.ac.uk so that we send information to the correct address.

Course start

Our Physiotherapy course starts on **16th September 2024**. Induction information will be available from late summer via our online welcome website.
