Interview Guidance

Congratulations on gaining an interview for our BSc (Hons) Physiotherapy course. The information in this booklet will assist you in preparing for your interview and will give you an idea of what to expect on the day.

You have been selected for interview on the strength of your application. We feel you demonstrate a range of attributes and qualities that indicate you have the potential to succeed as a healthcare professional. The process requires you to attend a formal online interview so that we have a chance to consider your suitability for our course. The interview will take place via an online platform called Microsoft Teams and will last approximately 20 minutes. You too must decide, based on your findings at interview, as to which university and course you think would best meet your needs as a learner.

Do remember that an interview is a two-way process and that you should treat the interview as an opportunity to ask the course team questions.

What to prepare in advance of the interview?

On the day of your interview, please have available:

- Photographic ID document. Please ensure that the photograph is recent enough to identify you. ***You will be unable undertake your interview without providing this.***
- Access to Microsoft Teams with video connection. ***If you will be accessing Microsoft Teams from a different email address to that on your UCAS application, please let us know as soon as possible.***

On the Day

Prior to your interview date you will be emailed a link to access your individual interview “room”. Please access the “room” 5 minutes before the start of your interview where you will be met by a member of the academic teaching team who will conduct your interview. They will check your photographic ID at the start of the interview.

What the interview will involve

The interview is designed to identify those applicants who demonstrate the values that align with the NHS Constitution as well as those who evidence the right skills and aptitude in accordance with Values Based Recruitment. We will also use the interview as an opportunity to explore the detail of your personal statement.
