Business Engagement and Beckett Careers are made up of four distinct strands:

1. **School Careers & Employability Consultants** – this team work across all of our academic Schools to provide everything from one to one coaching through to lectures and careers education modules across the breadth of our subject areas. In addition to delivering programmes of careers education, the team work with our academic colleagues in a consultancy capacity – advising on how to effectively build externally informed careers education into our subject areas. 2. **Central Careers & Employability team** – this team run our events programme ranging from traditional careers fairs, through to employer informed and led professional development programmes. These programmes are open to all of our students from any subject discipline, and are purposefully developed to expand our students perceptions as to how they can apply their studies, to encourage employers to consider students from the breadth of our subject areas (and demonstrate the potential these students can bring), and to respond to the changing labour markets and employer needs

3. **Experiential Learning Team** – this team work across academic Schools to support embedded experiential learning opportunities, and to generate a series of centrally focused opportunities which bring together students from across our subject disciplines. These opportunities can range from a one year sandwich placement, through to summer placements, micro internships, part time work and business challenge projects/competitions. 4. **Graduate Progression Team** – this team provide intensive outreach support for our graduates for up to 15 months after they have completed their studies. The team offer upskilling training for our graduates which support the development of industry ready skills such as project management, leadership, initiative etc. The team work with employer partners to contribute and inform development, and also have a role to work with employers to generate opportunities which will resonate and will be of interest to our graduates.
