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### **What is a Timed Assignment?**

This form of assessment is similar to an open-book exam, but you have a number of days in which to complete it. This means that you can choose when to do it, and select a time which fits with your other commitments, or spread the work over several days.

Questions typically require you to answer with a paragraph or a longer answer, but similar in length to what you would expect to write in an exam. There will be a maximum word count. Your module lead will inform you about whether they expect you to include key references in a reference list.

Like an exam, you should be able to complete a timed assignment on the basis of your learning through the semester and your preparation. It does not mean undertaking large amounts of additional reading during the release period. Your preparation may include making mind-maps or summary notes as you would for an open book exam. Again, your module lead will provide further information on this.

Because flexibility is already built into this assessment, there are no extensions. If you are ill during the week and unable to complete the assessment, you should apply for mitigation. Students with a learning contract who make use of a learning mentor should plan ahead for this and make a booking during the release period.

### **What is an Online Test?**

This form of assessment is like an exam that you access online. It is made available to you on MyBeckett for a certain period of time, to give you flexibility around when you do it, but you must arrange to be available for the amount of time allowed for the test without interruptions, as though you were taking an exam.

Once you access it you must complete it within a certain amount of time. There are a few **important things to note**:

- Access the test in **Google Chrome**. Other browsers can cause it to crash and you will be unable to complete it.
