Reflecting on Professional Practice

We want to support you through your NQT/RQT year by making your teaching experience count towards master's level credits. You can enrol on the NQT distance learning module and earn 20 credits towards a master qualification while you work with your school mentor in your NQT year.

The module will enable you to critically reflect on your performance and capability as a teacher working within the context of the Teachers' Standards. It is designed to support you in developing professional attributes, knowledge, skills and understanding in your practice. As a result, your teaching will become more effective and you will have an increasingly positive impact on the outcomes of the children you teach. Reflecting on Professional Practice is characterised by a critical approach to day-to-day practice in the key areas associated with the Teachers' Standards.

We will help you develop and use reflective practice to bring forward ideas to address the Teachers' Standards, enabling you to enhance your own practice and the practice of others. Additionally, the concept of reflective practice draws particular attention to the aims, values and social consequences of education.

During your module, you will need to compile an e-portfolio giving evidence of on-going personal and work-based research alongside proof of meeting the Teachers' Standards. To complete your course you will submit assessed tasks throughout the module including a final reflection of 1000 words that draws from the evidence of the completed tasks and your e-portfolio to highlight the progress that you have made against the Teachers' Standards over your NQT/RQT year. During your induction on campus you will meet, face-to-face, with tutors involved in the module. Through regular tutorial support on-line you will be able to obtain feedback on your progress. We also aim to develop peer support.
