### The EPIC Study - A reminder of the study aims

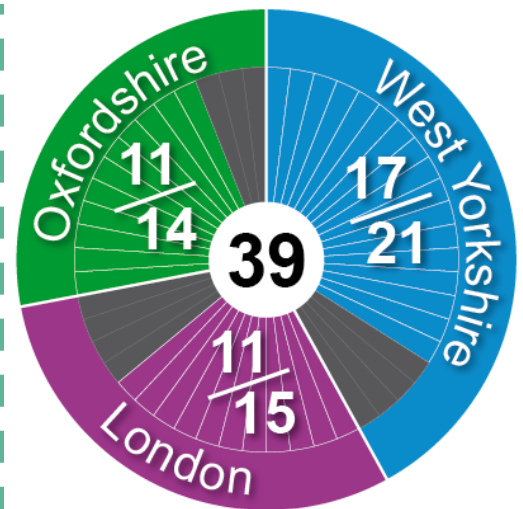
This study aims to improve the care given to people living in care homes. It will test a way of helping care for people which involves staff observing and recording care given to residents. This information is used to see if care can be improved.

Thank you for all your help so far with the study - speaking to the researcher and completing the questionnaires, it's much appreciated!

Depending on the stage of the trial in your / your relative's care home, the researcher will ask to meet with you once or twice more over the coming months.

We now have agreement from most of the homes who will be taking part in the study and 24 of these have been officially entered in to the study (the remaining 26 homes will be entered over the next 3 months).

Of these 24 homes, 374 residents and 100 relative / friends have so far agreed to take part.



Once a home agrees to take part in the study, the care home manager and owner sign an agreement. This shows how many agreements we now have in each area.
