The EPIC Study - A reminder of the study aims

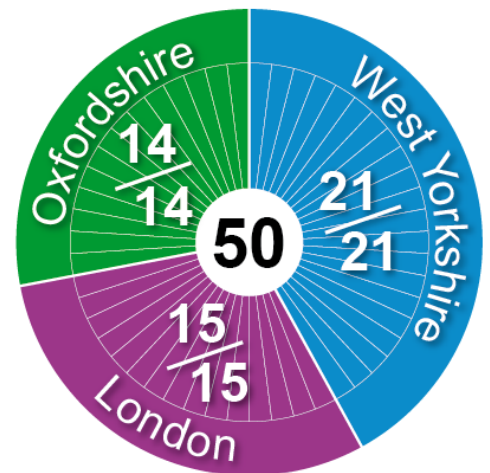
This study aims to improve the care given to people living in care homes. It will test a way of helping care for people which involves staff observing and recording care given to residents. This information is used to see if care can be improved.

Thank you for all your help so far with the study - speaking to the researcher and completing the questionnaires - it's much appreciated!

Depending on how long the study has been running in your / your relative's care home, the researcher will visit again once or twice more over the coming months.

We now have all of the homes we hoped to involve in the study - that's 50 Care Homes taking part!

From these 50 homes, 741 residents have agreed to take part.



As shown above, 50 care homes are now taking part in the study. This is broken down by area, so you can see how many other care homes near you are also taking part in the study.
