"Diversity is woven throughout our courses. Whatever area we're looking at, we try to make it inclusive and identify areas of difference."




You may already know the subject you want to study, but knowing which qualification is right for you may not be so obvious. Here is a quick guide to the types of qualifications we offer.

A degree is typically:

- Three years for a bachelors degree
- One year for a taught postgraduate masters degree

Route to a university degree

If you need to improve your English language score



University Preparation Courses (delivered by trusted partner Study Group)

Pre-sessional English language

This is a short course of between 8-12 weeks in length that helps you improve your English skills to study your degree. It will also help prepare you for university life and UK culture.

Foundation year

Foundation courses are one year and prepare you for your bachelors degree and UK university life. You will enhance

your academic and study skills, and for some subjects you can study your chosen course during your foundation year.

A foundation year is an ideal first step into higher education, building your confidence and academic skills so you can meet the entry requirements needed to progress on to your bachelors course. You can choose to study modules from your preferred degree as part of your foundation year, including business, law, social sciences, architecture or art and design.

Undergraduate

Bachelors – BA (Hons) / BSc (Hons) / BEng (Hons)

These are three-year courses which you apply for following high school or college. They stand for Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Engineering.

Sandwich course

This is a bachelors degree that includes a one-year work placement in industry. Normally you will study for two years before your placement year, undertaking your third year after your placement year.

MArch/MEng/MPlan

An Integrated bachelors and masters course that lasts for four years. You will start your bachelors degree in Year 1 and finish with a masters qualification.

Postgraduate — Taught

Masters – MA / MSc

A masters course is one year, although there are exceptions. You can study a Master of Arts (MA) or a Master of Science (MSc). You would usually study an MSc or MA following the completion of a bachelors degree.

PG Diploma

You will study about six modules from a masters course but will not be required to complete a dissertation or an independent project.

PG Certificate

You will study three modules from a masters course. You don't need to complete a dissertation or independent project.

Postgraduate — Research

MRes (Master of Research)

This is a stepping stone from undergraduate to PhD level research. With a focus on developing your research skills, this course usually takes one year to complete full-time.

MPhil (Master of Philosophy)

This programme of study requires high-level investigative research, evaluation and critical analysis skills. It is full-time across three years and your final thesis will be assessed by viva voce (oral examination).

PhD (Doctor of Philosophy)

Usually studied full-time over four years, a PhD is a programme of supervised research and is the highest level of postgraduate study. You will contribute new knowledge to your field of study.

PRE-SESSIONAL COURSES

If English is not your first language, our pre-sessional English language programme will help you achieve the required level of English to study one of our undergraduate or postgraduate degrees.

Delivered online by our trusted partner, Study Group Digital Learning, the 8-, 10-, or 12-week programmes are specifically designed for students holding a conditional offer that requires them to improve their English language level as (one of) the conditions before starting a Leeds Beckett degree.

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION YEAR

The International Foundation Year at Leeds Beckett University International Study Centre helps you to progress to your chosen undergraduate degree at Leeds Beckett University. You will spend two semesters in the supportive environment of the International Study Centre, working with expert tutors in order to confidently enter the first year of your undergraduate degree at the University.

Why study the International Foundation Year?

This programme is designed to help you feel confident joining the first year of your undergraduate degree at Leeds Beckett. Under the guidance of our expert tutors, you will benefit from:

- An academic introduction to your chosen subject area
- Additional English language modules designed for university study
- The chance to develop your academic study skills
- Lessons taught by staff who are experts in international education
- Smaller class sizes as part of a friendly, multicultural student community
- Help transitioning to the UK education system

What is Fee-Paying Study Abroad?

This programme provides the opportunity for you to study a selection of modules for one or two semesters at Leeds Beckett University. It's a great way to study in a new environment and experience British culture.

Flexible learning

Depending on the degree you are studying, you can choose modules from our undergraduate or postgraduate courses. You may be able to design your own programme* by selecting modules from different subject areas.

What will it cost?

This will depend on the number of modules you choose and the subject areas you want to study. To give an indication of the potential costs, the fees for an undergraduate course are around £8,200 per semester.





Unconditional offer

You have met the conditions of your offer and don't need to send us any further information until you are ready to apply for your CAS number (if required).

Steps 7 to 11 are relevant if you need a student visa and may not apply to all applicants.

Student contract

If we offer you a place to study at the University and you accept that offer, a contract will be formed between you and the University, as set out in the Student Contract. By accepting an offer to study at the University you agree to abide by the terms of the Student Contract.

Changes & updates

Every effort is made to ensure that the information in this publication is correct at the time of going to print (Aug 2025). Any changes to this printed prospectus, such as changes to courses, facilities, course arrangements and additional costs, will be made to the online version of the course as soon as is reasonably possible. It is therefore important that you refer to our website for up-to-date information, including the current position in relation to teaching and learning, accommodation, the campus, and the financial, health and wellbeing support provided to students immediately before accepting your offer. For the most up-to-date information about our courses, and entry requirements, visit: leedsbeckett.ac.uk/courses

The student's right to cancel

You are entitled to cancel the Student Contract within 14 days of the date of accepting a place to study at the University. In each year of your course you are also entitled to withdraw within 14 days from the date that teaching begins on your course. Where you have withdrawn within these periods you will be entitled to a full refund of fees paid to that point for that academic year.

Option modules

Where a course includes option modules that you can choose as part of your degree, these can be found on the course pages on the University's online prospectus. The availability of option modules is subject to demand, which may mean that not all option modules listed are available to you every year.

Course specifications

As part of the quality control at the University, courses are regularly reviewed. Course specifications in the online prospectus [leedsbeckett.ac.uk/courses] are updated annually to include modifications approved through the University's quality assurance process.

Complaints

If you are an applicant and have a complaint about the admissions process, you should use the Admissions Complaints Procedure. If you have a complaint about the University not related to the admissions process, then you should use the Student Complaints Procedure. If you are still unsatisfied, in many circumstances you have the right to refer your complaint to the Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education.

Course changes or cancellations

Following acceptance of an offer, if the course is cancelled or substantially changed from the description previously provided to you, the University will inform you by email of the changes and the reason for these changes, at which point you will have the option to explore suitable replacement programmes or withdraw your application with no liability for fees. For further details please refer to clauses 23-33 of the University's Student Contract. The University is required to make you aware of substantial changes to your course during the application process and once you are a student at the University.

Fees

Details of the course fees and any other costs relating to individual courses will be advertised pre-application online via the University's online prospectus. Assuming there are no breaks in your period of study, the course fees notified to you in your offer letter will remain unchanged for the duration of your course.

Legal liability

The descriptions in this prospectus are not part of the official University regulations and do not constitute an offer to you to study at the University. Please refer to clauses 52-56 of the Student Contract which sets out the circumstances in which the University limits its legal liability following the acceptance of an offer.

Important information for non-UK citizens


