
On arrival, please report to:

What to bring on the day

Though there is no need to prepare any material before the day, we do require you to provide evidence of your identity.

You need to bring your photographic ID (passport or driving licence) which will be checked at your interview. If you do not have photographic ID please bring along your birth certificate.

Your interview will take place with a member of the course team. As such, we recommend that you take advantage of this opportunity, to ask any questions you may have about the course, the University facilities or your future career in Childhood Development & Playwork.
