Academic Collaborations and Trans-National Education (TNE)

Trans-National Education (TNE)

TNE refers to 'all types of higher education study programmes, or sets of courses of study, or educational services (including those of distance education) in which the learners are located in a country different from the one where the awarding institution is based.' <u>http://www.qaa.ac.uk/en/Publications/Documents/TNE-Review-Handbook-2017.pdf</u>

Shared Delivery

The delivery and assessment of a University award (part/full) at a partner, by both partner and University staff.

Distributed Delivery (Off-Site)

The delivery and assessment of a University award at a partners' premise or via distance learning or a combination of both by University staff.

Franchise Delivery

The delivery and assessment of all or part of a University award at a partner, by the staff of the partner.

Validated Delivery

A course wholly or partially developed and delivered by a partner, potentially with University support and validated by the University.

Academic Partnerships

Exchange/Study abroad

This agreement enables our students to study at partner universities across the world with which we have formal exchange agreements.

Memorandum of Articulation

The University may choose to enter into an Articulation agreement with an institution where a course of study at that institution is recognised for direct entry to a university course of study after the normal point of entry.

Memorandum of Understanding

A non-binding, non-exclusive agreement with a partner body. This sets out a statement of intent but does not commit either body to specific outcomes. Any programme level arrangements subsequently approved require appropriate agreements.
