USER AGREEMENT

- This space may be used by our faith groups, as well as individuals to worship, socialise and meet during opening hours.
- The space does not belong to one specific group or faith community, and we expect everybody to treat each other with respect.
- The prayer facilities are for Leeds Beckett University students, members of staff and visitors to the University only. The facilities should not be used by members of the public unless they are attending an event at the University.
- The doors to the facilities must not be propped open.
- Please leave the Prayer Room as you found it, return any furniture etc to its original location, and make sure that the room is clean and tidy when you leave.
- Please do not bring alcohol into the room at any time.
- Please do not bring food or drinks into the room.
- Please do not leave lit candles or burning incense unattended in the room at any time.
- Please take care to keep all areas of the Prayer Room facility clean and tidy at all times.
- Please do not display posters or notices within the prayer room.
- You must have your Student/Staff ID card to gain entry.
- Mobile phones should be switched to silent, and calls should not be made.

ROOM CAPACITY

The prayer room can hold 30 people safely. Users must not exceed this limit. If you feel that too many people are using the room, please contact the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Team at equality@leedsbeckett.ac.uk.

FACILITIES MANAGEMENT AND STAFF ACCESS

University staff, Emergency Services and agents of the University (e.g. contractors) have the right and responsibility to enter the prayer facilities without obstruction when deemed appropriate by the University.

University cleaning staff will clean the room regularly. The main prayer room will be vacuumed once a week.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Lockers are not provided in the prayer facilities. Users are responsible for the safety of their belongings.

Please keep any valuable items on your person or near to you. If there are any security concerns, contact Security on 0113 812 3165 (24 hours).

GUEST PRAYER LEADERS

Guest prayer leaders and external speakers must be approved using the external speaker approval process as part of the University's events procedure. Student Societies will be supported to do this by the Leeds Beckett Students Union. Colleagues should refer to the University's events procedure.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Users are asked to abide by the University's usual procedures (including Health and Safety and Fire Evacuation) and treat others with courtesy and consideration at all times.

- The fire door should not be opened unless in the event of an emergency.
- Exits should remain clear of personal belongings.
- Users must not smoke in any of the buildings or near the doorways.

If the alarm sounds, you must leave the building at once via the nearest emergency exit and move well away from the building to allow access for the Fire Brigade. Failure to leave the building / follow fire warden instructions in the event of an alarm could result in disciplinary action.

TOILETS

The nearest toilets to the facilities are on the first floor of Woodhouse building (including accessible toilets).
