As part of this work, we have developed the LGBTQ+ Inclusion in Education Award to give your school a framework for a whole school approach to LGBTQ+ Inclusion, whatever your starting point.

You will translate your school's mission, vision and values into policies, processes and practice which support your commitment to having a rich whole school culture where all members of your school community thrive.

Who can apply

Any educational setting committed to working towards making excellent LGBTQ+ Inclusion a core part of your provision.

Duration

Schools will have up to a year to submit evidence, underpinned by a competency framework.
