Can the environment be made more **dementia friendly**?




e.g. clear signage, quieter areas to wait, activities, easy access to drinks and snacks

Be flexible,
ask what adaptations a person might need, and give extra time and support



Consider **transport and arrival** arrangements



e.g. support around drop-off and pick up, transport waiting times, support and areas

Ensure staff have access to good quality dementia **training and resources** to signpost patients and families to
