Urban grit was a short consultancy in 2021-22 that built on the Mapping Green Dublin project. Dr Schiffer fed design expertise into a number of internal meetings to support various project activities. She was also invited to facilitate a design thinking workshop with a small group of representatives from the Oliver Bond Estate/ Dublin 8 neighbourhood involved in urban greening as part of the Creative Ecologies Lab:	
<i>In June 2022 This participatory workshop is aimed at supporting people who are interested in taking action to enhance green spaces and/or biodiversity in their local area. It will be facilitated by Dr Anne Schiffer from the Leeds School of Arts who will introduce you to 'design thinking' as a framework for developing your ideas. She will take you through a number of practical exercises intended to support you at different stages of developing your project.</i>	
In addition, she facilitated a design thinking workshop for participants from the College of Social Sciences and Law at the University College Dublin to support their internal sustainability initiatives.
