
### ADDITIONAL Information Statement

A curated programme of performance and multi-media art, ReROOTed was commissioned by Arts Council England and Hull City Council for Hull 2017 UK City of Culture, with additional support from the Goethe Institute, the Quebec Council and the Canada Council. Through curatorial research practice, ReROOTed explored the previously unassessed archive of former artist-run organisation Hull Time-Based Arts (HTBA) in order to produce a programme exploring the local and national impact of HTBA on live and media art programming since 1984, and what its future might be.

Co-curated with Mike Stubbs, Dyson acted as lead curator of live art, co-curator of the archive programme, symposium Chair, and as a commissioned artist producing original work. Commissioned and collaborating organisations/artists included: Simon Poulter; Live Art Development Agency, London; FACT, Liverpool; Yorkshire Visual Arts Network; Buzzcuts, Glasgow; Live Art Bistro (LAB), Leeds; Assemble Festival, Hull; Res, London; The Culture, Place and Policy Institute, Hull University; The Institute of Cultural Capital; University of Liverpool; Liverpool; Liverpool John Moores University; and Werkleitz Gesellschaft, Germany.

The project produced multiple creative outputs including two curated exhibitions – one focusing on a new public presentation of the HTBA archive and a second for which Dyson and Stubbs commissioned new works including live art and a film (produced by Mal Williamson) along with co-ordinating artist panel discussions, screenings, and convening a symposium series. Dyson also produced her own new artwork: Coming Home – a live performance. The project research explored the impact potential of regionally located, community-based live arts programming.

Work curated and produced by Dyson was exhibited at venues including: Humber Street Gallery, Hull (including publication of an exhibition catalogue); Studio 11 Gallery, Hull (the first time that the gallery had shown live art); with live performances and exhibitions in public spaces across the Fruit Market district of Hull.

Integrating past and present media

arts practices, Remooted will inspire artist-led interventions, questioning our capacity to re-root and grow with reference to past, present political, social and geographical contexts.

It will include many new commissions; a Coils, video performance by Anne Bean (of the original Bow Gamelan with Paul Burwell and Richard Wilson) who performed Drums Along the Humber on the Marina in 1987; Alastair Maclennan with a new whilst Graham Dunning will make durational performance work; and NTBA Mechanical Techno through workshop, founding members Joanna Millett and Rob performed in a DJ night also including Gawthrop making a 3D film projection event celebrating Europe.

Nina Edge, Vicki Bennett (People Like Us), Ronald Fraser-Munro and Ann Whitehurst will also re-visit, bringing fun and political intervention. Irrerevant performance artists Gillian Dyson, Simon Poulter, and FK Alexander will stir things up.

Drystone waller, Dave Lynch will blockade Humber Street with redundant electronic equipment and Filippos Tsitopoulos will create masks and

costumes made from fruit on the site of the original fruit market.

In-keeping with ROOT Festival's international heritage Alexandre Burton from Montreal will be creating uncanny installation performance with Tesla

Original Ferens Live Art Officer Mark Waddell will place obtuse haiku into the public realm along with poetry,

A workshop and debate programme, 'round tables' will also take place over the weekend.

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


