Criteria for Digital Portfolios

Content

Where applicable, your digital portfolio must cover your final year degree projects in detail as this is likely to be the most recent academic work you have achieved. You may need to revisit this work if you think it needs enhancing in any way; does anything need redrawing or representing?

You need to include edited work from the rest of your education where you think there is something relevant.

The portfolio needs to be in chronological order.

Please make sure that the projects are clearly described and referenced.

Do not put in everything you have ever done, edit with a critical eye.

Please include any work that supports your application that was not part of the course e.g. competition entries.

Please include any professional work and clearly explain your role and the project. We are keen to see how creatively you have spent your career to date.

Please include a Table of Contents page that clearly states whether the work was done academically or professionally.

Technical

Your digital portfolio should be a single PDF file or equivalent (not individual files for individual sheets – this will not be accepted).

Please keep the file to a reasonable size that allows images to be clear but not so large that the file takes so long to open or email.

Website links are also acceptable if you keep your work on your own website.
