Criteria for Digital Portfolios

Portfolio Content.

Include in detail projects completed in the second and third years of Architecture BA (Hons), RIBA Part I, as this work is likely to be your most recent academic work. In addition, include any work that further supports your application; for example competition entries or work completed during other relevant undergraduate study. Professional work completed during or prior to a year out should also be added; clearly explain the projects and your role in the office. We are keen to see how creatively you have spent your year out.

The portfolio needs to be in chronological order. Please make sure that all projects represented are clearly described and referenced. You may need redraw or represent work for clarity.

Please include a Table of Contents page that clearly states whether the work was done academically or professionally.

Technical

Your digital portfolio should be a single PDF file or equivalent (not individual files for individual sheets this will not be accepted). Please keep the file to a reasonable size that allows images to be clear but not so large that the file takes so long to open or email. Website links are also acceptable if you keep your work on your own website.
