

High Achievers Scholarship

Academic Year 2014-15

Leeds Beckett University are offering scholarships worth £1000 to full time home and EU undergraduates starting in the 2014-15 academic year who hold three A level grades at ABB or qualifications which are approved SNC exceptions, a list of which can be accessed here (<http://www.hefce.ac.uk/data/year/2013/sncexempt1415/#d.en.83153> – further details may be released by UCAS in due course, please check the UCAS website for details)

Details

The High Achievers scholarship is paid as a fee waiver of £1,000 to reduce your 2014-15 academic year tuition fees. **The scholarship is applicable for the first year of study only.**

Eligibility

To be eligible for a High Achievers Scholarship from Leeds Beckett University you must;

- Be registered on a full-time undergraduate programme that is funded by HEFCE. Students studying on courses funded by the NHS or the Teaching Agency (initial teaching training) will not be eligible
- Be enrolled on year one of the course in the 2014-15 academic year
- Be charged tuition fees of £9,000 in 2014-15
- Achieve three A level grades at ABB or above or a qualification/grade combination which is listed in the link below.

Application Process

You do not need to make a direct application for this scholarship. If your qualification data confirmed by UCAS, or via a request from the University, indicates that you have attained the necessary grades the scholarship will be automatically awarded.

Payment

You will be notified if you have been awarded the scholarship and your tuition fee liability for 2014-15 will be reduced by £1,000. The University will notify the Student Loans Company of the reduced amount where applicable. The scholarship will be for one year only and may not be deferred for later commencement.

General

If you are in receipt of the High Achievers Scholarship you may be eligible to receive any other scholarships, bursaries or discounts offered by the University.

The University reserves the right to vary or withdraw the scholarship at its sole discretion.
