

Beckett Achievement Award 2017/18

Overview

The Beckett Achievement Award is a one-off cash award for all undergraduate students with a household income below £25,000. It is available to students entering the University in 2017/18 achieving an average 60% or more across Level 4 with no repeat year required, and enrolling fully for Level 5 in the following academic year.

Eligibility Criteria

You may be entitled to the Beckett Achievement Award, provided that you meet the following essential criteria:

1. Enrol on an undergraduate degree course for the first time in September 2017 at Leeds Beckett University; and
2. Be assessed to pay home fees and charged at the 2017/18 undergraduate fee rate for new entrants; and
3. Be eligible for student support from Student Finance England – includes EU residents but excludes students ordinarily resident in Scotland, Wales and N. Ireland. Have applied for and qualified for student support under the current *The Education (Student Support) Regulations* and consented to share financial information with the University; and
4. Have a residual household income of £25,000 or less as verified by the SLC; and
5. Achieve an average 60% or more across Level 4 with no repeat year required; and
6. Fully enrol for Level 5 on the same course at Leeds Beckett University; and
7. Remain fully enrolled on your course up to the payment of the award.

Application Process

There is no application process for this Award. We will use the data held within our systems to identify eligible students, and will be in touch with eligible students by November of their second year (Level 5) to confirm the award.

Payment

Payment will be made in one instalment directly into the bank account in to which you receive your student loan. Payment is made in early December, on the basis that you remain enrolled on your course. It is your responsibility to advise the SLC of any change to your bank details at least a fortnight ahead of any award payment date.

General
