

Placement Support Bursary 2017/18

Overview

The support for students accessing placements is intended to assist full-time undergraduate students commencing studies from September 2017 that require financial support towards travel and/or accommodation for either a short (e.g. 4-8 weeks) or sandwich/year-long placement where support is not available from elsewhere.

The amount payable will be assessed based on individual circumstances, and students wishing to apply will be asked to complete a short application and provide supporting documentation.

Please note that eligibility for the placement support bursary only applies to students starting courses in September 2017. Students who meet the eligibility criteria listed below will be contacted by the university and invited to complete the online application for the bursary. If you believe that you meet the eligibility criteria, but have not been contacted about the bursary, please email bursaryandscholarship@leedsbeckett.ac.uk

Students can make one application for the bursary per academic year.

Eligibility Criteria

You may be eligible for Placement Support, provided that you meet the following essential criteria:

1. You complete the short application in full and provide the relevant supporting documentation; and
2. You provide evidence that you are undertaking either a short (e.g. 4-8 weeks) or sandwich/year-long placement; and
3. You provide a copy of your Student Finance Entitlement Summary Letter from Student Finance England, demonstrating an assessed household income less than £25,000 per annum; and
4. You remain fully enrolled on your course up to the payment of the bursary; and
5. You provide us with details of your sort code, account number and name of your bank so that we can pay the bursary directly to you via BACS.

Application Process

If you wish to apply for this support towards either a short (e.g. 4-8 weeks) or sandwich/year-long placement you should complete the relevant application form, available online or via email from the Bursary & Scholarship Officer from September 2017.

If you did not tick the relevant box during online enrolment then you should contact the Bursary & Scholarship Officer, including the information detailed above, and they will ensure you are considered for the bursary.

Payment

Payments will be made in one instalment directly in to your nominated bank account.
