





Summary of general arrangements


<p>Fire alarm zones</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Note that the Woodhouse Building interconnects with the Portland Building and Leslie Silver Building. • The fire alarm might sound in those buildings but not in the Woodhouse Building or vice-versa; this is normal. • The fire alarm might also sound in some parts of the Woodhouse Building but not others; this is also normal. • If the fire alarm sounds in the part of the building you are in, proceed along the nearest safe evacuation route. • Signs will light up above doors that connect to areas that you must not enter.
<p>Alarm tests:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The fire alarm audibility test is undertaken on Thursdays. • The test will last for no more than 15 seconds. • If an alarm sounds for more than 15 seconds or on any other day, you must evacuate.
<p>Evac-chairs</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An evac-chair is available to evacuate mobility-impaired people from levels above Ground. • The evac-chair is located behind the Security reception desk near the main entrance on the Ground floor.
<p>Refuge Intercoms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The stairwells shaded in green on the floor plans below are protected stairs, and the landings of those stairwells can be used as a temporary refuge that is safe from smoke and flame ingress for at least 30 minutes when the fire doors are closed. • Communication with the evacuation management team can be made by phoning the University's Security Emergency number on 0113 812 4444.
<p>Final exits with level access</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Note that some escape routes from some parts of the building involve negotiating stairs. • If at any point you require assistance, contact the Security Emergency number on 0113 812 4444.
<p>Lifts</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The lifts cannot be used in the event of the fire alarm being activated.




Protected Stairwell










