

CARES CLEANING CHARTER

As we move towards a more flexible and hybrid way of working, we will continue to closely follow Government guidelines around hygiene and cleanliness.

Regular handwashing remains a key message from the Government and Public Health England in controlling the virus. We continue to do our best to make sure the Campus environment is suitable for working and studying in.

Please see below the measures we are taking to ensure this:

'Normal' Cleaning Routines

Daily cleaning is taking place. This includes the dusting and vacuuming of all teaching and communal areas, mopping & sanitising of washrooms and the wiping down of all surfaces with a suitable disinfectant.

All offices (where open and in use) are cleaned fortnightly, and deep cleaning – which involves carpet cleaning, high level dusting and hard floor cleaning – takes place on a rolling schedule throughout the year.

Additional Measures

Hand sanitiser is widely available across University buildings in communal and teaching spaces.

In addition to our standard clean, we continue to carry out extra services and provide additional cleaning supplies for self-use:
